6. Nature of contract:

Global price.

7. Contract description:

The purpose of this contract is to strengthen the infrastructural capacity of the Directorate General of Migration Management in order to effectively implement the EU–Turkey readmission agreement and to advance the implementation of the visa liberalisation roadmap by preparing documentation for the construction of 6 new removal centres. Under the contract, such services will be requested as:

- cost estimation, mapping, surveying, soil investigation and preparation of geotechnical reports of sites,

- detailed feasibility studies considering environmental, legal, technical, financial and socio-economic aspects with a cost benefit analysis,

- preparation of architectural designs and design reports,
- preparation of terms of reference and cost estimation for supervision services,

- preparation of works tender dossier in accordance with FIDIC and PRAG.

8. Number and titles of lots:

No, 1 lot only.

9. Maximum budget:

1 700 000 EUR.

10. Scope for additional services:

The contracting authority may, at its own discretion, extend the project in duration and/or scope subject to the availability of funding up to a maximum not exceeding the length and value of the initial contract. Any extension of the contract would be subject to satisfactory performance by the contractor.

Conditions of participation

11. Eligibility:

Participation is open to all legal persons participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers which are established in a Member State of the European Union or in a country or territory of the regions covered and/or authorised by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed (see item 29 below). Participation is also open to international organisations. Participation of natural persons is directly governed by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed.

12. Candidature:

All eligible natural and legal persons (as per item 11 above) or groupings of such persons (consortia) may apply.

A consortium may be a permanent, legally-established grouping or a grouping which has been constituted informally for a specific tender procedure. All members of a consortium (i.e., the leader and all other members) are jointly and severally liable to the contracting authority.

The participation of an ineligible natural or legal person (as per item 11) will result in the automatic exclusion of that person. In particular, if that ineligible person belongs to a consortium, the whole consortium will be excluded.

13. Number of applications:

No more than 1 application can be submitted by a natural or legal person whatever the form of participation (as an individual legal entity or as a leader or member of a consortium submitting an application). In the event that a natural or legal person submits more than 1 application, all applications in which that person has participated will be excluded.

14. Shortlist alliances prohibited:

Any tenders received from tenderers comprising firms other than those mentioned in the shortlisted application forms will be excluded from this restricted tender procedure unless prior approval from the contracting authority has been obtained (see 'Practical Guide' — PRAG 2.4.3). Shortlisted candidates may not form alliances or subcontract to each other for the contract in question.

15. Grounds for exclusion:

As part of the application form, candidates must submit a signed declaration, included in the standard application form, to the effect that they are not in any of the exclusion situations listed in Section 2.3.3 of the PRAG.

16. Subcontracting:

Subcontracting is allowed.

17. Number of candidates to be shortlisted:

On the basis of the applications received, between 4 and 8 candidates will be invited to submit detailed tenders for this contract. If the number of eligible candidates meeting the selection criteria is less than the minimum of 4, the contracting authority may invite the candidates who satisfy the criteria to submit a tender.

- 20. Initial period of implementation of tasks:

The consultant shall submit all outputs of the project within 12 months. Moreover, the contractor will be available to provide assistance for preparation of clarifications and corrigendum during tender and implementation periods.

Selection and award criteria

21. Selection criteria:

Same criteria for legal and natural persons.

The following selection criteria will be applied to candidates. In the case of applications submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole:

1) Economic and financial capacity of candidate (based on item 3 of the application form). In the case of the candidate being a public body, equivalent information should be provided:

Criteria for legal and natural persons:

- the average annual turnover of the candidate must exceed 1 700 000 EUR for the last 2 financial years.

2) Professional capacity of candidate (based on items 4 and 5 of the application form):

Criteria for legal and natural persons:

— at least 10 permanent staff currently work for the candidate this year (2015) in fields related to this contract.

3) Technical capacity of candidate (based on items 5 and 6 of the application form):

Criteria for legal and natural persons:

1. the candidate has provided services under at least 1 contract, with a budget of at least 500 000 EUR (proportion carried out by the candidate) in design and tender dossier preparation of accommodation centres such as dormitories, reception-removal centres, detention centres, hotels, etc., which was successfully implemented at any moment during the following period: 3 years prior to the submission deadline of this application (the start and end/completion dates of the references should be specified as day/month/year). According to the above expression, the referenced contract could have been started or completed at any time during the indicated period, but it does not necessarily have to be started and completed during that period, nor implemented during the entire period. Candidates/tenderers are allowed to refer either to contracts completed within the reference period (although started earlier) or to contracts not yet completed. In the first case, the contract will be considered in its whole if proper evidence of performance is provided (statement or certificate from the entity which awarded the contract, proof of final payment). In case of contracts still ongoing, only the portion satisfactorily completed until the date that is within the reference period will be taken into consideration. This portion will have to be supported by documentary evidence (similarly to contracts completed) also detailing its value. Only the related value for the requested services/activities for the above criteria should be specified. If a candidate/tenderer has implemented the contract in a consortium, the percentage that the candidate/tenderer has successfully completed must be clear from the documentary evidence, together with a description of the nature of the services provided.

Previous experience which caused breach of contract and termination by a contracting authority shall not be used as reference.

An economic operator may, where appropriate and for a particular contract, rely on the capacities of other entities, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. It must in that case prove to the contracting authority that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary for performance of the contract, for example by producing an undertaking on the part of those entities to place those resources at its disposal. Such entities, for instance the parent company of the economic operator, must respect the same rules of eligibility and notably that of nationality, as the economic operator.

If more than 8 eligible candidates meet the above selection criteria, the relative strengths and weaknesses of the applications of these candidates must be re-examined to identify the 8 best candidates. The only factors which will be taken into consideration during this re-examination are:

— the total number of references managed by the candidate which satisfy the technical capacity criterion 21.3.1,

— for the cases with equal standing after the first re-examination; the total amount of the contracts (proportion carried out by candidate) fulfilling the technical capacity criterion 21.3.1.

Best value for money.
